

Dr. Philip Mansel's books include Constantinople: City of the World's Desire (1995); Levant (2010), on Smyrna, Alexandria and Beirut; Aleppo (2016); and King of the World: the life of Louis XIV (2019). Louis XIV was an ally of the Ottoman Empire, which his agents crossed in search of antiquities, manuscripts, rare plants, and topographical information. He is a founding committee member of the Society for Court Studies and the Levantine Heritage Foundation, and is currently writing a history of nineteenth-century Europe.
